Fabrics for in and outdoor blinds and sun protection made of polyester, polyester flame retardant, Trevira® CS and recycled polyester, polyester in blends with viscose and polyamide in different designs, uni coloured, disperse, pigment and yarn dyed, pigment printed, aluminised, embroidered, embossed, crashed, partly coated with polyurethane, vinyl acetate or acrylate (also as mixtures) partly with pearlized effect and aluminium, also glued and with foil lamination made of polyurethane or polyethylene terephthalate, partly produced with fibres or finished with products having flame retardant properties accepted by OEKO-TEX® and partly finished with biological active products accepted by OEKO-TEX®; textile fabrics for digital printing made of polyester, Trevira® CS and cotton in white and white/coloured as well fabrics for use as shower curtain made of polyester, uni coloured or pigment printed, hydrophobized with acrylate coating, partly produced with fibres or finished with products having flame retardant properties accepted by OEKO-TEX®; produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class IV** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for decoration material.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.

The certificate D07-0710 is valid until 31.12.2021
